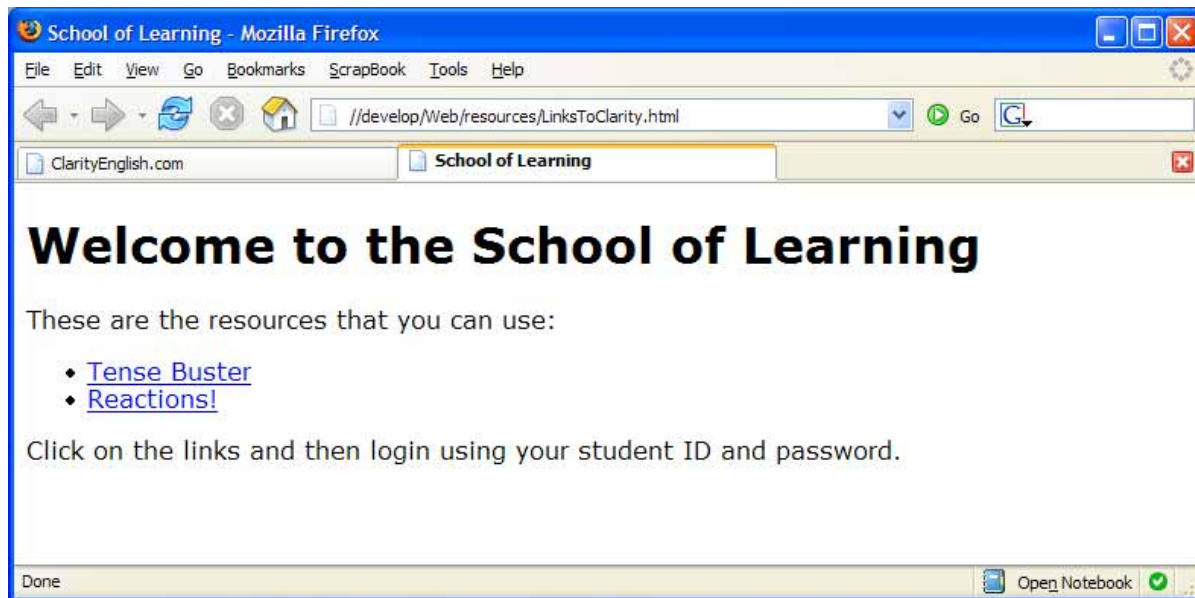




Clarity Online Materials: Linking to ClarityEnglish.com

You can add links from your own web page to the titles running on ClarityEnglish.com. A very simple page might look like this:



The details of the html to create the links are as follows:

In the following notes, XXX is a code that Clarity creates for you when you start your subscription – you can ask us for it or you can see it yourself in the html once you have logged into www.ClarityEnglish.com with your account name.

1. The simplest link is to open Tense Buster in a new browser window:
`Tense Buster`
2. A neater approach though is to open Tense Buster in a pop-up window as the browser navigation buttons can confuse some learners when they are using Tense Buster. The link would look like this:

And you would need to include the following javascript in your webpage (or use a similar script of your own).
