How do I do an activity?

Follow the four steps below:

4. When you have finished, click **Marking**. You will see your score. After marking, click on either the **Feedback** button or the answers to see feedback. (Not all activities have feedback.)

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How do I use the Recorder?

Follow the steps below:

A. To record yourself

1. Click **Record**. Then start speaking.

2. When you have finished, click **Stop**.

3. Click **Play** to listen to yourself.

4. You can click **Save** to make an mp3 file.

B. To compare with an audio in Tense Buster

1. Open the Recorder.

2. Play the audio file in the exercise.

3. Click **Compare**.

4. Record yourself saying the words in the exercise audio then play the two side by side.
