### Test features

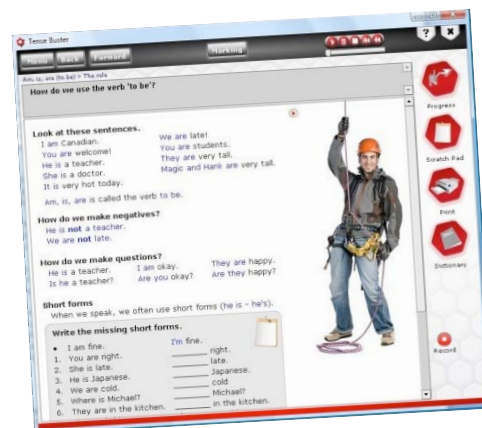
Each unit in Tense Buster includes a randomized test drawn from 50 questions based on the grammar area covered in that unit. Additionally, learners can generate random tests from multiple grammar areas in a level. The Tense Buster question bank includes 1,650 items.

### Progress features

The Tense Buster Progress function generates reports on completed activities with score, time, duration; average scores compared with all learners; relative performance in different units (effort and outcome).

Teachers using Results Manager can generate and print reports for individual learners and groups of learners.

Tense Buster (optionally) integrates with Author Plus, which enables teachers to add, delete, reorder and amend activities, and with Results Manager (see *Progress features* above).
